

**THE PATIENT RECORDS OF CLEANSLATE CENTERS ARE PROTECTED BY FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATIONS. CLEANSLATE CENTERS ARE REQUIRED BY 42 CFR PART 2, §2.22 TO PROVIDE ITS PATIENTS WITH THIS NOTICE.**

Generally, CleanSlate Centers including its employees and agents (e.g. externs, interns, contractors, etc.) (altogether “CleanSlate”) may not say to anyone outside of CleanSlate that a patient is receiving treatment at CleanSlate or identify a patient of CleanSlate as an alcohol or drug abuser without the patient’s written consent, disclosure permitted by a court of law, or when the disclosure is being made to medical personnel in connection with a medical emergency or to qualified personnel for research, audit, or CleanSlate evaluation.
